All rounds will take place at 7:00 p.m. at the Ramon Theater in Frostproof. The Elimination rounds are Friday, March 9 and Saturday, March 10, 2012. Winners of the Elimination Rounds will compete for the \$1000 grand prize on Saturday, March 24, 2012. There will be an optional rehearsal on Thursday, March 8, 2012 at 6:00 p.m. (required for Grades K-8).

The contest is open to all persons who live, work or attends school in Frostproof, Babson Park, Lake Wales, Fort Meade, Avon Park or persons who graduated from high school in one of the communities. Children and spouses of persons who work in these communities are eligible. Parents or guardians of children who attend school in these communities are also eligible. Part-year residents are eligible. Children must be in kindergarten or higher. Professionals are not eligible: A professional is someone who earns 25% of their income performing. Groups of two to five persons of kindergarten age and above may compete as a single act if 40% of the members of the act meet the eligibility requirements. Frostproof Rotarians, parents, siblings or children and former winners of Frostproof's talent competitions are not eligible to compete.

Persons competing will be asked to provide proof of eligibility. A person may compete in only one act. Competitors agree that Frostproof Rotary may take photographs of performers and use them in media articles and advertisements.

Acts lasting more than 5 minutes will be disqualified. You must furnish musical instruments and stage props. Piano and sound equipment will be provided. Only bands may use their own sound equipment. You must furnish your own performance-ready soundtracks. Dress must be tasteful. No obscene or suggestive language or actions are allowed. No dangerous materials (such as fire) may be used in any act. Doing so will result in removal from the stage and disqualification from this and future competitions. You must submit a copy of the lyrics and words to be used in your performance with your application.

The Grand Prize is \$1000. Prizes will be awarded to the following Age Groups: \$50 Grades K-3; \$50 Grades 4-5; \$100 Grades 6-8; \$100 Grades 9-12; \$100 Adult; \$100 Seniors 55+.

After the application deadline, you will receive a mailing, which will include the date you will compete in the elimination round, general instructions, and information on buying tickets. Performers may view the competition for free only on the days they are competing.

There is no cost to compete.

Only the performers are allowed in the backstage waiting area, except one parent may accompany a child in kindergarten to 5th grade.
